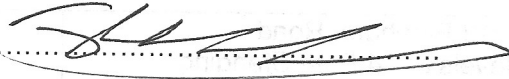

EP784	AG4 Street Furniture <u>Litter Bins.</u> The Clerk gave an update on Bins. - The bulk bin order has been delivered. The cost totalled £5,300.00 from the existing Environment & Planning budget. We now have :- 7 Free Standing Bins , 9 Post Mounted Bins and 1 Extra Large Bin which we still need to acquire the steel inner for it. - Previously agreed bins will hopefully be installed within the next couple of weeks. One post mounted bin near the flower bed at Farm Foods. 1 Free Standing bin along the Western Flyer. 1 Free standing bin at the new bus stop on Cricklade Road Opposite Clive Parade. 1 Free Standing bin at the bus stop	

	outside 112 Pinehurst Road. Leaving stock levels at:- 4 Free Standing 8 Post Mounted and one extra-large. Cllr Patey asked if the bin installed on Great Western Way had been re-located to the bus stop on Whitehouse Road. The Clerk responded that he thought the job had been completed a couple of weeks ago. Cllr Yeowell mentioned bins being placed at the bus shelters in Ferndale ward. <u>Benches</u> The request for a memorial bench to be placed somewhere in Penhill has been purchased by the family member. The resident along with Cllr Beale decided to site the bench within Penhill Park. We have taken delivery and installation will be within the next couple of weeks. Cllr Beale stated that she thought it may well have been installed earlier in the day. Cllr Beale also enquired about the Lipsy one. The Clerk confirmed there was no installation date as yet and it was still with the Borough. Cllr Beale asked to speak about another wanted bin in Penhill. In support of a local volunteer who regularly litter picks in the vicinity. (Exact location to be confirmed.) Cllr Beale confirmed she would like to make a resolution and get it ratified at full council. The Clerk mentioned one more issue of littering which is occurring at the Moonrakers, from cars stopped at the traffic lights. The idea of placing small signs on the traffic lights at car height was suggested. These would remind people of the dangers faced by ground crews who have to clear it. Cllr Patey enquired about CCTV in the area. The Clerk responded about the issue of enforcement and confirmed that there is an item on Full council this month to look at issues with enforcement. Cllr Yeowell reminded the committee the upcoming litter pick occurring on the 23rd of September within the Parish.	A Briggs to assess the locations inline with policy.

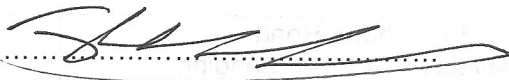
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
