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CD041	Tobacco Control Strategy Update The Chair provided a verbal update on the Tobacco Control Strategy. In conjunction with Swindon Borough Council we are looking at creating Smoke Free Zones outside in specific areas like sporting areas, paths community centres etc. The Chair proposed the new Moredon Sports Hub to be a completely Smoke Free Zone. A discussion was held about the practicalities of managing that and possible fines. It was agreed that sanctions like banning would be more efficient than fines. A discussion about whether to include vaping as well was had, and it was agreed that a blanket ban on both smoking and vaping. The Chair asked Mr A Reeves to produce a series of recommendations to take to Full Council to be discussed and agreed. Councillors VOTED on whether they agree to making Moredon Sports Hub a Smoke Free Zone for both smoking and vaping and to NOTE the report. RESOLVED councillors agreed to make Moredon Sports Hub a Smoke Free Zone for both smoking and vaping and NOTED the report.	Mr Andy Reeves to produce a series of recommendations to take to Full Council.
CD042	Community & Youth Officer Update The Community & Youth Officer presented a written report. The Food Cookery Initiative Program starts this Friday working with Wiltshire Police and Swindon Academy School, supporting children on the verge of exclusion from mainstream school (possible gang culture involvement). Four children have been identified who will be working with Mr A Webb, Manny (PCSO), community worker from Swindon Academy and a PC, focusing around cooking to work with them. Community Pop-up shop extremely popular still with winter months necessity foods needed. Sporting Tots session running up to Xmas starting Thursday 9th November.	

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	Current programs Wednesday Youth Meet, Friday Football, and SNATCH sessions still ongoing across the parish. October half term program starts in two weeks across the parish. The Chair asked about the Youth Council. The provision of bike repair centre kits has been asked for. A discussion was held including about providing training on puncture repair for local people. RESOLVED: Councillors NOTE the report from the Community & Youth Officer.	
CD043	Assets Manager Update The Clerk presented a written report from the Assets Manager. A new Zumba class starting on the 5th October. Train Master starting 27th October based around train tracks and ride on trains, arts and crafts and dressing up. The Reading Room is in demand by care companies booking it for training courses. JMH has a new yoga group starting 6th November. Martial Arts is continuing and attendance is positive. Swindogs Big Art Trail is concluded.
