Moredon Youth Sessions:

We've been running youth sessions every Tuesday and Thursday from 3:30 PM to 5:00 PM. The Tuesday sessions cater to younger participants (Years 6-8), while the Thursday sessions are for older students (Years 9-11). We've been attracting around 6-8 participants on Tuesdays and 10-12 on Thursdays, with numbers steadily increasing.

Friday Football Sessions: Our free Friday Football sessions are held on the Moredon Astro from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM. These sessions consistently bring in 10-12 young people and have been a great way to promote physical activity and community engagement.

Disability Youth Sessions: We have recently moved our disability youth sessions to Morden from Pinetrees. They now run from 4:15 PM to 5:00 PM, providing a dedicated, supportive space for young people with disabilities.
