

Community Youth Report

October Half Term Activities

During the October half-term break, we organised an outing for a group from the Moredon Sporting Hub to Go Ape. Also, we conducted detached sessions across several areas, including Moredon, Penhill, Pinehurst, and Gorse Hill, to reach and connect with young people directly in their neighbourhood's. Our youth club sessions continued as planned, offering a consistent space for young people participate in structured activities.

Penhill Skate Park Consultation

We recently held a consultation at JMH regarding the proposed Penhill skate park, where residents shared their views and concerns. While some questions were raised about the potential for antisocial behaviour (ASB) associated with the skate park, the overall feedback was positive, with many community members happy with the future of the site.

Youth Club and Friday Football Sessions

Our youth club sessions at both Moredon Sporting Hub (MSH) and Pinetrees are ongoing, providing regular programming for local youth. Friday Football, a popular part of our activities, has expanded to run across two venues and numbers are growing. Additionally, the disabilities sessions held every Friday at MSH continue to provide inclusive opportunities for youth.
