Easter Half Term Activities

During the Easter Half Term, the youth team successfully delivered youth sessions across all three sites: MSH, PSH, and Pinetree's. Two sessions were held daily at each location. Additionally, two trips were organised: one to a local arcade and another to Wembley Football Stadium, providing experiences for the young people.
