Pop up shop – At Pinetrees Community Centre on the last Friday of the month we have a free pop up shop, which has cupboard staples- soups, rice, pasta, sauces, cereals, tinned veg, tinned fruit and toiletries. Local people can come along on the last Friday of the month and take up to 6 items. We normally get between 15 & 20 people each month. The funding for this came from at the time Cllr Will Stone's ward allowance, this will run out next month (July). The pop up shop helps a numerous people and families especially as times are hard and with the rising costs of food and toiletries.
