Breakfast Club

Funding provided by the Parish Council has enabled us to launch Breakfast Drop-In sessions twice a week, supported by breakfast items and an additional 15 minutes of staffing time. In just four days of delivery, participation has grown rapidly from 20 pupils on the first day to 102 pupils by day four, clearly demonstrating both need and demand within our community. These sessions are already having a significant impact on pupils' readiness to learn, ensuring children start the day well-nourished, settled, and ready to engage in learning. Staff have observed improvements in punctuality, focus, and emotional readiness, particularly for some of our most vulnerable pupils. This funding is making a tangible difference to children's daily experiences and is helping to create a positive, supportive start to the school day for families across our community.
