EP-2026.68.i	AG68.i S/COND/26/0957 – Discharge of Condition (3) External ventilation/machinery, from previous application S/26/0422 – Change of use of former ATM Building to a Hot Food Takeaway (Sui Generis) together with the installation of a service hatch and associated signage (sign board and fascia sign). Former ATM Clive Parade Swindon Cllr P Exell noted that the Councillors did not have the technical knowledge to comment on the application. RESOLVED – NO COMMENT

EP-2026.68.iv	AG68.iv S/HOU/26/0975 – Erection of single storey rear extension. 16 Little Avenue Rodbourne Cheney Swindon SN2 1NL Councillors discussed the application. RESOLVED – NO OBJECTION	
EP-2026.68.v	AG68.v S/HOU/26/0984 – Erection of a first-floor rear extension. 1 Atbara Close Rodbourne Cheney Swindon SN25 3DD Councillors discussed the application. Cllr P Exell proposed objecting due to the impact on light amenity to neighbouring properties. RESOLVED – OBJECTION	
EP-2026.69	Street Furniture • Litter Bins - Mannington Rec Cllr M Khan presented an update on the issues with overflowing rubbish bins at Mannington Rec. He explained that due to heavy use of existing rubbish bins they are regularly overflowing, and residents have asked him if this issue can be addressed. Mr A Reeves noted that Cllr M Khan is correct. More residents are using the parks, and the Parish needs to look at supporting residents by possibly increasing bin pick ups rather than increasing the number of rubbish bins. Cllr P Exell mentioned that damaged dog bins will be replaced with normal bins. He proposed replacing the two damaged bins, placing a new bin close to the MUGA and rearranging the existing bins to provide better coverage of the area. Cllr D Patey suggested investigating the use of providing additional bins during events. RESOLVED – APPROVED - Londis, Church Walk South Cllr P Exell explained that Mr R Kimber, RCRA Chairman requested a permanent bin be placed on Church Walk South. Mr A Reeves explained that a lot of the surrounding area is	

	privately owned which is why placement of one so far has not been possible. Councillors mentioned that Londis should be responsible for providing a bin to manage waste created from their business. Councillors discussed the application. Cllr P Exell proposed communicating with the Landlord to request permission to fix a rubbish bin to the wall or install a pole to fix the rubbish bin to which would need emptying regularly. RESOLVED – APPROVED - Nightingale Rise Mr A Reeves explained that this bin has suffered a lot of vandalism over the years. Cllr P Exell proposed replacing the bin. RESOLVED – APPROVED - 200 Moredon Road Cllr P Exell proposed placing a free-standing bin next to the bus stop next to 200 Moredon Road. RESOLVED – APPROVED - Bin Purchase costs Cllr P Exell presented an update on investigations into steel and plastic bins. Councillors discussed which bins to purchase. Cllr J Woods asked about anti-graffiti bins. Mr A Reeves explained that metal bins are easier to clean than the plastic ones. Cllr P Exell proposed purchasing the metal bins and to order as many as can be purchased to use up the budget allowing the Parish to take advantage of the bulk discount.
